

## Skins and Pins

Skins and pins is a common game. A skins game can be play with “gross” or “net” scores. For NWGA purposes we will pay “gross” *or* “net” scores on each hole but not both. “Skins” are available on every hole; you can win the “skin” on a hole by having the sole lowest gross/net score. The value of a “skin” is determined by how many holes are won outright.

Pins are just what you think. On par3’s the closest tee shot to the pin wins (#10 and #12). For added fun Marsha and I decided to add a twist. Since we are on Arrowhead and the par 3’s on the front are difficult to drive from the tee we insert our twist. On holes 5 and 7 we will be doing *closest 2<sup>nd</sup> shot* to the pin unless someone drives the green then it reverts to closest tee shot to the pin. (If you drive either 5 and/or 7 please measure your distance and enter this on the sheet: your name, drove the green, feet, inches)
