Bramble or Shamble

A bramble starts off just like a scramble: the members of each team (usually four players per team) tee off, and the best drive is selected. In a scramble, this process continues until the ball is holed, producing one team score.

In a Bramble, all team members tee off, then the team selects which drive they like the best. Again all members hit the 2nd shot from the chosen location. The 3rd shot is where the format changes. From this point on each player plays their own ball, stroke-play style, until it is holed. This produces four individual scores. Your *team* score is the best score of the 4 scores.

The bramble tournament also goes by the name of "shamble." The team score can be the one low ball of the group, the two low balls, or some other variation depending on the tournament director's instructions.
