Blind Nine

Blind Nine, sometimes called Blind Hole, is a tournament in which only 9 of the 18 holes count in the player's final score. The catch is that the players don't know which 9 holes count until after the round is completed. Each player plays her own ball throughout the round.

The tournament organizers usually wait until all teams have teed off before randomly selecting the 9 holes whose scores will be used.

Blind Nine is played with half handicaps.
