## Green and/or White... What's your flight?

Green or White golf tournament format refers to the color of the tee markers. If your club uses different colors, or has more than three tee boxes, think of this as the Forward and Middle tournament. (aka: Whine and cheese party.)

First divide the field into two flights by HDCP. Label the flights "green" and "white", with the "green" flight having the higher HDCP's. In this game each player plays their own ball throughout. The "green" flight plays from the forward (or "green") tees and use full HDCP's. The "white" flight plays from the middle (or "white") tees and use full *adjusted* HDCP's. Hence the name "Green or White… What's your flight?".

Winners are determined across the entire field, pay low gross and low net prizes.

**Variation 1:** is to play it as a 2 player team event. Once the flights are set then pair a player from the "white" flight with a player from the "green" flight. At the end of each hole the 2 player scores are added together to determine the teams score. To determine a team HDCP simply combined the two HDCP's. Pay low gross and low net team prizes.

**Variation 2:** Two players hit from the forward tees, and two from the mid-tees for the whole game. Be sure to use the mid-tee slope when determining the handicap for the players using this tee. Add the four net scores for a team game score.
