

Red, White and Blue (the Blues)

The red, white and blue in the title of the Red, White and Blue golf tournament format refers to the color of the tee markers. If your club uses different colors, or has more than three tee boxes, think of this as the Forward and Middle tournament.

First divide the field into two flights by HDCP. Label the flights “red” and “white”, with the “red” flight having the higher HDCPs. In this game each player plays their own ball throughout. The “red” flight plays from the forward (or “red”) tees and use full HDCPs. The “white” flight plays from the middle (or “white”) tees and use full *adjusted* HDCPs. Hence the name “Red, White and the Blues” the white flight is unhappy.

Winners are determined across the entire field, paying low gross and net.
