

## **Blind Front or Back**

Blind Front or Back, is like Blind Nine, except this time you divide the field in half. Half the field will use their front 9 score, and the others will use their back 9 score. The catch is that the players don't know which 9 holes they will be playing until after the round is completed. Each player plays her own ball throughout the round. You will use 50% HDCP. Gross and net winners for both front and back.

**Version 1:** Now do a blind partner scenario. Here you blindly pair a front 9 player with a back 9 player, to get a total 18-hole score. Calculate a team HDCP by using 50% of their combining HDCP. Have gross and net winning teams.
