

Addition and Division or Add & Divide

For each hole, the partners' scores are added together and then divided by two for the score of the hole. At the end of the game, total the holes and deduct the handicap. Partners' handicaps are added together and then divided by two for the team handicap.

Variation 1: A & D can be played w/ dotted cards. If the final team score on a hole involves a decimal point you record your team score with a decimal point.

Example: Player A scores a 4 and Player B scores a 5 the total is $9 \div 2$ for a team score of 4.5 (4 and half). You record a 4.5 on your score card.

Variation 2: Play with 4-person teams. If by chance you have a threesome have their fourth score be a rotation of their three scores. Rotate in this order; low score-middle score-high score, and repeat.
